TRIP TO WILDWOOD DEVON

I am pleased to be able to write to you about our forthcoming trip to Wildwood Devon, which has been booked for **Tuesday 4th March 2025**, leaving at 9am and returning just before the end of the school day.

Why Wildwood?

As you know, we have been enjoying our '*Invaders and Settlers*' topic this term in Discovery, finding out more about the history of the Saxons and Vikings in Britain. In order to conclude this period of learning, we will be taking part in a 'Living History' workshop at Wildwood, which is based at Escot, near Ottery St Mary. We will be visiting their authentic Saxon village, and taking part in a variety of activities including daubing, metalwork, foraging, breadmaking, dressing up and more!

In addition, they have conservation exhibits of a variety of British wildlife which we will also see during our visit.

Payment

The cost of this trip will be **£24 per child** which includes transport, the cost of entry to the park and all the activities.
